We are pleased to be presenting a workshop with Frank Bruckmann, a Connecticut fine artist. Frank began his studies at the DuCret School of Art in New Jersey and then took classes at the Art Students League in NYC. In Paris he studied at the Ecole des Beaux Arts, and spent nearly a decade in France and Spain, copying the masters in the great museums, and painting landscapes in the cities and countryside. Now a resident of New Haven, Frank has found endless subject matter for landscapes in New England, but periodically packs his easel and travels farther and wider for inspirational subject matter. For this workshop, "Painting from Photographs", feel free to use oils, water-soluble oils, acrylics or pastels. Suggested canvas or pastel paper size is 12 x 16, 16 x 20, or slightly larger if you choose.

Frank will start with an approximately 1 hour demo showing his block-in procedure and will then work with all participants on the subject of your choice. Bring a photograph of landscape, still life, portrait, etc, from which to work.
